Dear Residents and Neighbours,

What's been happening on Life and Mind Building Oxford, I hear you ask – well let us tell you...

As we come into the middle of the summer period, the LaMB project is flying on all fronts. We have now installed over 200 of the precast panels to the Flex Research building, completed the Structural frame to the future office block and have commenced the new unitised façade system.

Now our building is adequately protected from the weather, our fitout teams are hard at work installing the drylining walls & 1st fix Services. In the lower ground we have started taking deliveries of the large plant and equipment so that we can commence fitting out the plant room spaces.

Elsewhere; we have commenced work on upgrading the Mansfield Service Yard, which is a much needed tune-up, that will provide the Mansfield estate with better access and parking facilities. We have also commenced works on the creation of two new secure cycle parking spaces, once completed will provide an additional 218 bays for cycle parking
