- The last tower crane has been removed

What we are doing now:

The laboratory spaces in the flex block are now entering into the final phase of installation and we are preparing our first spaces for inspection by the client's team within the coming weeks.

Removal of the internal scaffold in the Feature Atrium space which will allow us to concentrate on applying the finishing elements.

Progressing the final elements of first and second fix in the Lower Ground Floor including the lecture theatres.

Progressing the internal finishes in the office building, with Client team inspections due to start a short while after the flex.

Installing the steelwork structure for the glass lift in the scoop, and completing the waterproofing to allow install of the cladding elements.

During the summer vacation period we will continue elements of the external works to the front of the Chemistry Teaching Labs, the service yard, and works around the perimeter of the site including provisions for the hard and soft landscaping. We will also carry out some improvements to the service road entrance from Mansfield Rd, with these works carried out overnight to minimise any disruption to other users.

Our entrances will be adapted to provide access for some of the summer works so you will find that the information board, electronic info totem and book collection box will be relocated further along St Cross Rd, nearer to our compound entrance.
